29.1 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 28th GOVERNING BODY MEETING

29.2 FOLLOW-UP ACTION TAKEN ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE 28th MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY – A BRIEF SUMMARY

- i. The Principal informed the Governing Body that an Admission Office has been constructed newly and it's starts functioning.
- ii. The Principal informed the Governing Body about the status of construction of Classrooms/Laboratories above the Civil Engineering Block to meet the requirement as per the natural Growth.
- iii. The Principal also informed the Governing Body about the status of the construction of the facilities for AICTE IDEA Laboratory.

- iv. The Principal informed the Governing Body about the status of the Recruitment of Faculty Positions for the AY 2025-26.
- v. The Principal was pleased to inform the Governing Body that a new Basketball Court has been constructed.

29.3 DETAILS OF VARIOUS APPROVALS AND ACCREDITATION STATUS

- i. The Principal informed the Governing Body about the details of the courses offered in the AY 2025-26.

- ii. The Principal informed the Governing Body about the NBA Accreditation status of B.E.-CSE, B.E.-ECE & B.E.-Mechanical programmes for the period of three years from 2023-24 to 2025-26.
- iii. The Principal informed the Governing Body about the e-SAR for the Accreditation of B.E.-EEE and B.E.-EIE had been submitted and Expert Committee visit dates has been suggested to NBA, New Delhi during the month of August, September and October 2025.
- iv. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the NAAC Accreditation was valid up to 31.12.2024 and appropriate action has been taken to renew the accreditation status from NAAC. He also informed the members about the period of validation has been extended by NAAC until the introduction new accreditation system (Maturity-Based Grading) and the AQAR 2024-25 was in preparation in order to submit to NAAC in the month of December 2025.
- v. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the Approval of AICTE (EoA) has been received for the 11 UG & 9 PG courses to be conducted in the academic year 2025-26 from the AICTE, New Delhi.
- vi. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the Application was submitted to Anna University to receive the Affiliation in order to conduct 11 UG & 9 PG Courses in the AY 2025-26. All processes were completed and Affiliation order from the Anna University yet to be received.

- vii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that to strengthen the acumen of the students regarding the corporate working pattern, an exclusive 'Corporate Advisory Board' (CAB) has been functioning in each department.

29.4 REPORT ON THE PRESENT STATUS OF TEACHING STAFF & STUDENTS

- i. The Principal presented the status of Faculty in SRMVEC, a total of 235 qualified Faculty members (8 Faculty members were recruited during 1st Dec 2024 to 31st July 2025) including 116 Doctorates. There are 97 Faculty members pursuing their Ph.D. Degrees.
- ii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that 242 Faculty Members are required in order to maintain the FSR 1:20 as per the norms of AICTE & Anna University for the Academic Year 2025-26.
- iii. The Governing Body was informed that the average age of the Faculty members is 39.4 years and average experience is 13.7 years.
- iv. The Principal informed the Governing Body that 76 faculty members completed SWAYAM (NPTEL/NITTTR) / FOSS Certifications during 1st Dec 2024 to 31st July 2025.
- v. The Principal presented the status of the Students in SRMVEC; a total of 3,979. It includes 3,461 UG students and 518 PG students.

29.5 REPORT ON ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES & APPROVAL OF VARIOUS SYLLABI

- i. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the all the departments have arranged a total of 37 Industrial visits to their students and faculty members to enhance their domain knowledge and totally 1,254 students and 324 faculty members were benefited.
- ii. The Principal was pleased to inform the Governing Body that 20 MoU's have been signed with industries and various activities has been carried out during 1st Dec 2024 to 31st July 2025. Totally 67 MoU's have been signed with various industries as on date.
- iii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that a total of 48 Ranks have been obtained by the Students in the year 2023-24.
- iv. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the Curricula & Syllabi for the 11 UG courses and 8 PG Courses (R2023) and MCA (R2024) to be offered in the AY 2024-25 were framed by the respective Board of Studies and it was approved by 7th Academic Council meeting held on 17th April 2025.
- v. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the Academic Audits for all Programs were conducted as per UGC norms during December 2024/January 2025.

- vi. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the New ISO 21001:2018 Certification (EOMS) proposal was in process and the ISO 9001:2015 Internal audit was conducted on March-June 2025.
- vii. The Governing Body was informed that the 'Faculty Induction Programmes (FIP)' have been conducted in 23rd & 26th December 2024 for the 29 newly joined Faculty members.
- viii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the Alumni Meet "SHIMMER" has been conducted on 08.12.2024. Totally 12 Events were conducted by Alumni and 975 Students were benefited during 1st Dec 2024 to 31st July 2025.

29.6 REPORT ON PLACEMENT OF STUDENTS

- i. The Governing Body discussed the Placement achievement during the last academic year. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the SRMVEC has achieved following placement percentage during 2025-26.

- ii. The Governing Body was informed that the intensive Campus Placement Training Program for the purpose to train students to match the industries' expectations were conducted.
- iii. The Governing Body was informed that the a Special Training Programmes Training Programme for II & III Year students were conducted to Enhance the Employability Skills in order to groom their Personality traits, Problem solving Skills, for the betterment of the students while attending the Interviews.
- iv. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the highest pay package bagged by student is Rs. 12 Lakhs CTC offered by VTS ENTERPRISES INDIA PVT LTD.
- v. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the 'HR Conclave' and 'Meet & Greet' Events were conducted.
- vi. Dr. K. Parthipan member of Governing Body suggested strengthening the infrastructure of the Department of Placement.
- vii. Dr. K. Parthipan member of Governing Body suggested bringing more core companies for the better placement of non circuit branch students.

29.7 REPORT ON RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

- i. The Principal was pleased to inform the Governing Body that 9 Departments were approved as Research Centres by Anna University, Chennai.
- ii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that 35 Faculty members were recognized Research Supervisors in different Universities.
- iii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that 9 Faculty members were conferred with Doctorates during Dec' 2024 to July' 2025.
- iv. He also informed the Governing Body that 49 SCI/Scopus Research Papers were published in the reputed journals by the faculty members Dec' 2024 to July' 2025 with h-index of 36 and also 7 Text books were published by the faculty members.
- v. Dr. K. Parthipan member of GB suggested increasing the article publications so that it can be very useful in obtaining NIRF rank, etc.
- vi. The Principal was pleased to inform the Governing Body that the incorporation of AICTE IDEA Lab Scheme worth Rs. 90 Lakhs in SRMVEC.
- vii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that all the Faculty members are advised to submit the research proposals to the various funding agencies to get funded projects. Rs. 65.8 Lakhs worth Research Proposals were submitted to various funding agencies like AICTE, DST, ICSSR, TNSCST, etc. during Dec' 2024 to July' 2025 [*Rs. 4.45 Lakhs sanctioned*].
- viii. Dr. K. Parthipan member of Governing Body suggested to follow-up the funding proposals submitted to various agencies.
- ix. The Principal was pleased to inform the Governing Body that Rs. 7.65 lakhs Seed money from SRMVEC management is sanctioned for four departments.
- x. The Principal was pleased to inform the Governing Body that 39 Patents have been filed by the Faculty members and 5 Patents were published and 5 Patents were granted during the during Dec' 2024 to July' 2025.
- xi. The Principal informed the Governing Body that Centre of Excellence in IoT, Cyber Security, Cloud Computing, Machine Learning, Network Security and Robotics, Graphics and Multimedia, Robotics, etc., were setup in the respective departments.
- xii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the SRMVEC Library renewed a MoU with DELNET, New Delhi to enrich the Library resource of e-Books and e-Journals.

- xiii. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the SRMVEC Library was renewed 127 Printed Journals at the cost of Rs.4.45 Lakhs and 6,981 online journals were renewed at the cost of Rs.8.44 Lakhs.
- xiv. The Principal informed the Governing Body that the SRMVEC Library has the total no. of volumes: 51,601, Titles: 17,078 and e-Books: 1,897.
- xv. The Principal informed the Governing Body that 184 Faculties in 55 Industries attended the Faculty Industry Immersion Program (FIIP) and 9 faculties were attended the Indian National Academy of Engineering (INAE) and Infosys Foundation initiative on Centre for Engineering Education Excellence (CEEE) Program in collaboration with IITs and AICTE during the summer 2025.

29.8 REPORT ON CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- i. The Principal informed the Governing Body that a Budget of Rs.59.17 lakhs for 260 events (49 Guest / Expert Lectures, 11 Workshops, 15 Seminars, 11 Symposia, 12 Conferences, 24 FDP/ MDP/ SDP/ STTP, 51 NSS/NCC/YRC/Rotaract, 24 Sports and 8 Tamil Mandram etc.) for various extra & co-curricular activities for the academic year 2024-25 was allocated and we have successfully conducted for the benefit of students and staffs.
- ii. He also informed the Governing Body that various events conducted by the NSS, NCC, YRC, Student Affairs Cell, Sports, Paarivendhar Tamil Mandram, Kani Tamil Pervai and Rotaract Club for the Students.
